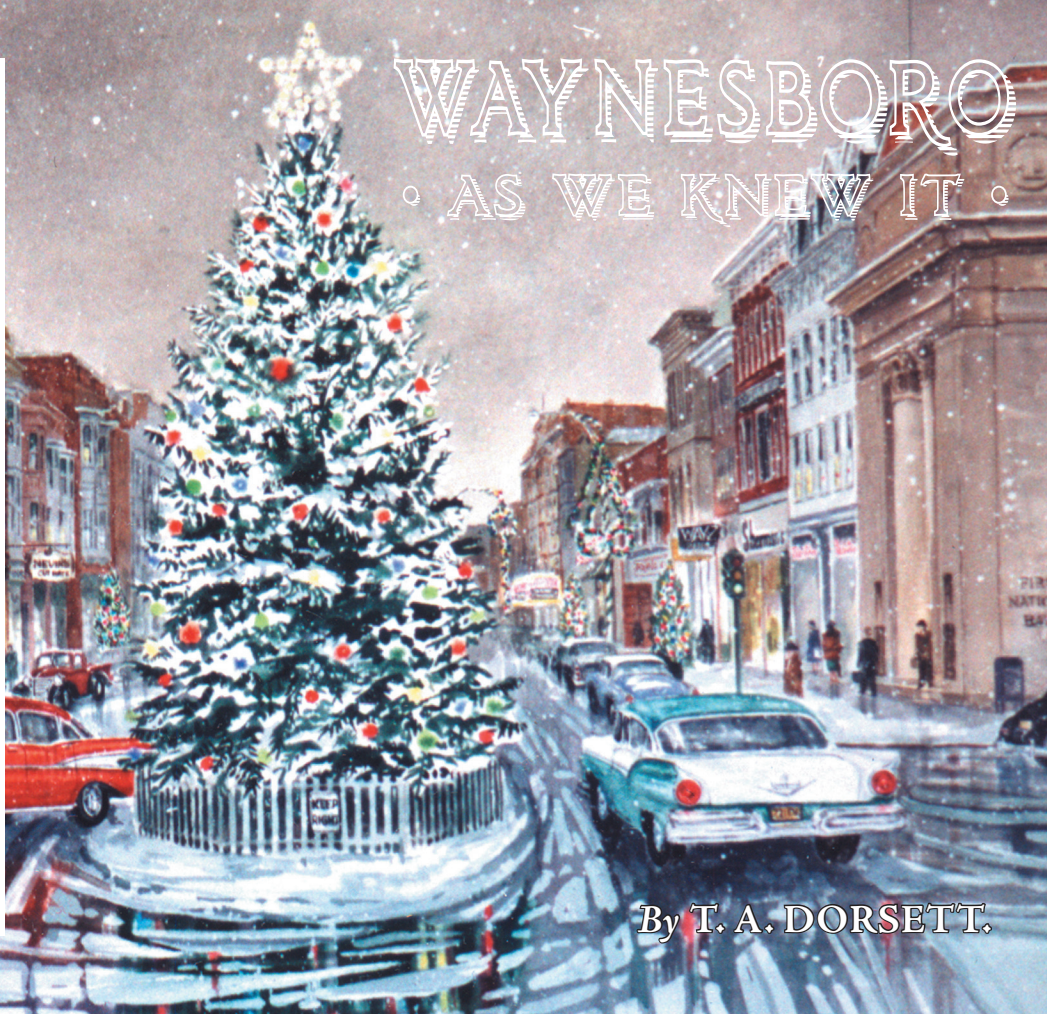

Waynesboro As We Knew It, by T. A. DORSETT, recounts the history of Waynesboro, Pa., from its beginnings to the waning days of the 20th century through reminiscences, anecdotes, journal and diary entries, letters, pictures, and even a sociological monograph—collected by the Author for forty years.

Beginning with memories from an aged former slave, the story includes descriptions of the old town at various times in the 19th and 20th centuries, the early plight of children, a visit to the Bell Pottery Shop, the excitement before and during the Civil War, the arrival and passing of railroads and the trolley, the machine-tool industries, local “characters,” rambles along Antietam creek, 20th-century modes of entertainment, champion football teams,

etc. It ends with the Author's own reminiscences about the town in the last half of the 20th century. A fifth-generation resident of Waynesboro, T. A. Dorsett knows the town well, and tells its story with a wit and sympathy that will endear it to readers.

The dustjacket is a watercolor by the late Landis Brent Whitsel, showing downtown Waynesboro during a Christmastime snowstorm in the late 1950s.
